Welcome New Terrier Families!

The college is excited to kick off New Student Orientation on Saturday, Aug. 26. We want to share what the first few days on campus will look like for you and your student. Attached are the new student and family orientation schedules. We also want to share the following information that was shared with your student at the end of last week. Those living oncampus also received specific information about move-in at the residence halls on Friday as well. Commuter students should plan to check in at the Mungo Student Center as well and

join us at the Opening Session.

What to expect at check-in

New Student Orientation Check-In will be open between 8-11 a.m. on Saturday, Aug. 26. Before your student or any of your family can get in line to unload into their residence hall (if they're living on campus), the student must first complete the check-in process at the Mungo Student Center.

At check-in, all students will receive:

- Wofford student ID card
- Wofford student parking decal
- Advising information
- Important orientation materials
- …and more!

If they are living on campus, students also will receive their:

- Room key
- Specific unloading instructions for their residence hall room
- Unloading lane passes

Mobile check-in card

To expedite the check-in process, students will want to make sure to complete all of the items listed on their FYI checklist (located on the myWofford website under the FYI tab). When you arrive to check in at the Mungo Student Center, your student will be prompted to present their mobile check-in card. This card, accessible on any device connected to the internet, will show the staff if the student has any mandatory items needing to be completed before they can check in. They can also access their mobile check-in card at wofford.edu/checkin.

Please have your student check their card today and resolve any outstanding items. Any incomplete items will have to be completed before they can receive their new student packet. If they have trouble completing any tasks in the portal, please have your student contact the appropriate office below.

Parents of returning students

In an effort to provide a more conducive move-in experience this year, we will provide a weekend check-in time. Below are the available check-in times for returning students this fall:

Sunday, Aug. 27 from 1-4 p.m. Monday, Aug. 28 from 8:30 a.m.-5 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 29 from 8:30 a.m.-5 p.m.

Returning students can check in at any point during the available check-in periods and do not need to schedule a specific time of arrival.

Check-in will be held in the lobby of the Mungo Student Center. Students who do not properly check in will be fined for failure to check in and may also experience temporary loss of building access.

Early arrival requests may be submitted through the Early Arrival Request form located on the housing portal. All early arrival requests must be submitted by 5 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 11 at 5 p.m. There is a narrow timeline for making space available for fall, and staff will be participating in training leading up to the week of check-in. Therefore, many early arrival requests are unable to be accommodated unless there is a high level of need, with no available alternatives, and the space is ready prior to student arrival.
